PPE LIST:

1. N95 RESPIRATORS

These masks are critical in helping to protect healthcare workers from droplets and aerosols

2. SURGICAL MASKS

Although not as secure as N95 masks, surgical masks do offer a significant degree of protection against droplets with COVID.

3. PROTECTIVE GOGGLES

Eyes/Eyelashes are a known source of transmission of COVID, especially in aerosolizing procedures.

4. GLOVES (Nitrile, non powdered)

We are running low on gloves, a critical item in the hospital in patient care.

5. FACE SHIELDS

To assist in preventing droplets and airborne COVID from entering our eyes, a known source of transmission

6. WIPES: DISINFECTANT

These wipes are critical to wiping down medical machinery, workspaces, computers and rooms after patients have been in them
